Political Election Signs in the Right-of-Way

Policy authored by Managing Director

The following criteria must be met for the placement of political election signs within Kent County Road Commission right-of-way:

- 1. Signs shall not be larger than nine (9) square feet
- 2. Signs shall be a minimum of fifteen feet (15') from the paved surface
- 3. Signs shall not be placed in vision corners, typically at least one hundred fifty feet (150') from the intersection of another public street
- 4. All signs must be removed within 10 days after the election

Signs not adhering to this policy will be removed and stored at one of the Road Commission facilities:

- 1. 1500 Scribner Avenue NW in Grand Rapids
- 2. 4949 Tim Dougherty Drive SE in Grand Rapids
- 3. 11777 White Creek Avenue in Cedar Springs
- 4. 131 84th Street SW in Byron Center

Removed signs will be stored for one week. The Road Commission reserves the right to collect a handling and storage fee for excessive violation of this policy.
